BLUE EARTH PHYSICIAN RE-ELECTED TO MMA BOARD OF TRUSTEES

MINNEAPOLIS – The Minnesota Medical Association has re-elected Terence P. Cahill, M.D., to serve a three-year term representing the Southwest District on the MMA Board of Trustees. The MMA is a professional organization representing about 10,000 physicians, fellows, residents, and medical students in Minnesota. The election was held September 15 in Minneapolis during the MMA's 153rd Annual Meeting.

The Board of Trustees manages the affairs of the MMA between sessions of the House of Delegates.

Dr. Cahill is a family physician practicing in Blue Earth, Minnesota. He received his medical degree from the University of Minnesota Medical School and completed his residency at Charleston Naval Hospital in South Carolina. Currently he is the vice president of the Minnesota Academy of Family Physicians and is on the Minnesota Community Measurement Reporting Advisory Group. He has also been a member of the Midwest Medical Insurance Company Board of Directors, the MMA Quality Committee, the MMA Health Care Reform Task Force and the chair of the MMA Committee on Legislation.
