ROCHESTER PHYSICIAN ELECTED TO MMA BOARD OF TRUSTEES

MINNEAPOLIS – The Minnesota Medical Association has elected W. Neath Folger, M.D., to serve a three-year term representing the Southeast District on the MMA Board of Trustees. The MMA is a professional organization representing about 10,000 physicians, fellows, residents, and medical students in Minnesota. The election was held September 15 in Minneapolis during the MMA's 153rd Annual Meeting.

The Board of Trustees manages the affairs of the MMA between sessions of the House of Delegates.

Dr. Folger is an assistant professor of neurology at Mayo Medical School and a consultant in neurology at Mayo Clinic in Rochester. He received his medical degree from the University of Texas and completed his residency in neurology and his fellowship in electroencephalography at Mayo Graduate School of Medicine. He is a member of the American Academy of Neurology, the American Association of Electrodiagnostic Medicine, the American Medical Association, Zumbro Valley Medical Society and the Minnesota Medical Association.
