MINNEAPOLIS PHYSICIAN ELECTED MMA SECRETARY-TREASURER

MINNEAPOLIS —The Minnesota Medical Association has elected Carolyn McKay, M.D., as secretary-treasurer. The MMA is a professional organization representing about 10,000 physicians, fellows, residents, and medical students in Minnesota. The election was held September 15 in Minneapolis during the MMA's 153rd Annual Meeting.

Dr. McKay is a pediatrician practicing in Minneapolis and Eagan. She has served as commissioner of health for the city of Minneapolis, and as director of the Maternal and Child Health Division of the Minnesota Department of Health. Dr. McKay also served on the state Crime Victims Reparation Board, the Children's Home Society of Minnesota Board, and the state Health Technology Advisory Committee.

The secretary-treasurer maintains records of the official business of the MMA, proceedings of the Board of Trustees, and a register of physicians licensed to practice in the state of Minnesota as well; reports on expenditures; and chairs the MMA Committee on Administration and Finance.

Dr. McKay is the immediate past treasurer of the MMA. This year the offices of treasurer and secretary have been replaced by the office of secretary-treasurer. Dr. McKay has served as an AMA delegate and alternate delegate.
