CLOQUET PHYSICIAN REELECTED TO AMA DELEGATION

MINNEAPOLIS – The Minnesota Medical Association has reelected David D. Luehr, M.D. to serve a two-year term as alternate delegate to the American Medical Association House of Delegates.

Luehr practices family medicine at the Raiter Clinic in Cloquet. He chairs the MMA Quality Committee and is the MMA representative to the AMA Physicians Consortium for Practice Improvement. He has served the MMA as president, and chair of the Nominating and Leadership Development Committee. He has served as a member of the MMA Committee on Medical Practice and Planning and of the MMA Committee on Legislation.

AMA alternate delegates attend meetings of the AMA House of Delegates, participate in the development of AMA policies on health care issues, and at the state level, take part in policy development through the work of the MMA Board of Trustees.

The MMA is a professional organization representing about 10,000 physicians, fellows, residents, and medical students in Minnesota. The election was held during the MMA's 155th Annual Meeting in St. Paul Sept. 17-19.
