MANKATO PHYSICIAN ELECTED TO AMA DELEGATION

MINNEAPOLIS—The Minnesota Medical Association has elected Paul C. Matson, M.D., of Mankato, to serve a two-year term as a delegate to the American Medical Association House of Delegates.

Matson, a board-certified orthopedic surgeon with the Orthopaedic and Fracture Clinic in Mankato, has served the MMA as president and chair of the Board of Trustees. He has been a past chair of the MMA Committee on Legislation and served on the MMA Health Care Reform Task Force. He is currently an alternate delegate to the AMA and will begin his term as delegate in January.

AMA delegates attend meetings of the AMA House of Delegates, participate in the development of AMA policies on health care issues, and at the state level, take part in policy development through the work of the MMA Board of Trustees.

The MMA is a professional organization representing about 10,000 physicians, fellows, residents, and medical students in Minnesota. The election was held during the MMA's 155th Annual Meeting in St. Paul.
