EDEN PRAIRIE PHYSICIAN REELECTED TO MMA BOARD OF TRUSTEES

MINNEAPOLIS—The Minnesota Medical Association has reelected Beth A. Baker, M.D., of Eden Prairie, to serve a three-year term representing the West Metro District on the MMA Board of Trustees.

Baker is board-certified in internal medicine, occupational medicine and medical toxicology. She is a staff physician and a prior residency director at the Occupational and Environmental Medicine (OEM) Residency Program at HealthPartners. She also works at Boynton Health Services at the University of Minnesota and at Specialists in OEM in St. Paul.

Baker is an assistant professor in the Medical School and the School of Public Health at the University of Minnesota. She has served as chair of the MMA Committee on Public Health. She is chair of the Medical Services Review Board for the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry.
